



**FIRST ADDENDUM TO REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS
FOR BIOSOLIDS HAULING AND LAND APPLICATION SERVICES
CLEAN WATER SERVICES**

ADDENDUM ISSUED: APRIL 27, 2021

Clean Water Services' Request for Proposals for Biosolids Hauling and Land Application Services dated April 13, 2021 (RFP) is amended as follows:

1. Delete Paragraph 9 of the Proposal Contents, Section C, of the Proposal Instructions section of the RFP and replace it with the following:

“ 9. Insurance requirements

Contractor will be required to meet all of the insurance requirements in Paragraph 11 of the Contract for Biosolids Hauling and Land Application Services attached as Exhibit D. Contractor will submit copies of certificates showing it has insurance that meets the requirements in this section of its proposal.”

2. Delete Paragraph 11 of Exhibit D and replace it with the following:

“11. Insurance

A. Neither Contractor nor any subcontractor will commence work under this Contract until Contractor has obtained all the insurance required in this section and submitted a certificate of insurance to District. Contractor will maintain the insurance for the duration of this Contract. Review of the insurance by District will not relieve or decrease the liability of Contractor. Contractor will provide for 30 days advance written notice to District's Risk Manager prior to cancellation. The following insurance is required:

“i. Automobile and Umbrella Liability Insurance. Contractor will maintain automobile liability and, if necessary, commercial umbrella liability insurance with a limit of not less than \$2,000,000 each accident. Such insurance will cover liability arising out of any auto (including owned, hired, and non-owned autos). Coverage will be written on ISO form CA 00 01, CA 00 05, CA 00 25, or a substitute form providing equivalent liability coverage. Coverage will also include Pollution liability insurance in an amount not less than \$2,000,000 each accident at least as broad as that provided under the ISO pollution liability—broadened coverage for covered autos endorsement (CA 99 48) will be provided, and the Motor Carrier Act endorsement (MCS 90) attached.

- ii. Commercial General Liability (CGL) insurance covering bodily injury, personal and advertising injury, property damage, including coverage for independent contractor's protection (required if any work will be subcontracted), premises/operations, contractual liability, products and completed operations, in per occurrence limit of not less than \$1,000,000, and aggregate limit of not less than \$2,000,000.
- iii. Workers Compensation Insurance as required by ORS Chapter 656. Such insurance will include Employers Liability coverage in the following minimum amounts: Bodily Injury by Accident - \$500,000 each accident; Bodily Injury by Disease - \$500,000 each employee; Bodily Injury by Disease - \$500,000 each policy limit. Unless exempt under ORS Chapter 656, the Contractor and all subcontractors will maintain coverage for all subject workers. Contractor will provide evidence that any subcontractor performing work or providing goods or service under the Contract has the same types and amounts of coverages as required herein or that the subcontractor is included under Contractor's policy.

B. The automobile, general and pollution liability insurance coverages will name Clean Water Services as an Additional Insured, with respect to Contractor's activities to be performed, or products or services to be provided. Coverage will be primary and non-contributory with any other insurance and self-insurance.

C. Notwithstanding the naming of additional insureds, the insurance will protect each additional insured in the same manner as though a separate policy had been issued to each, but nothing herein will operate to increase the insurer's liability as set forth elsewhere in the policy beyond the amount or amounts for which the insurer would have been liable if only one person or interest had been named as insured.”

Except as modified in this Addendum, the RFP will remain in effect as originally written.
